INTRODUCTION TO COMPUTERS FINAL GRADE PERIOD PROJECT

A brief introduction to the Final Grade Period Project .:

- 1. It will account for approximately 40% of your 6th Grade Period Score
- 2. It needs to demonstrate your ability to apply basic computer skills, in word processing and/or page layout programs, to effective communication to a larger audience
- 3. It will need to integrate Text and Graphics

[You may petition the text/graphic requirement by providing a written proposal for an alternative project; this must be done during the preparation proposal period of this project. The alternative must be approved by the instructor.]

Tentative timeline:

- Project proposal: FIRST DRAFT due on or before May 12 [20 points]
- Formal approval of rough draft/sketch due May 18 [20 points]
- Final Draft due May 24 [45 points]
- FINISHED PRODUCT due June 2 [35 points]

It will involve:

- 1. a project that will actually be used by a CLUB, school or business
- 2. evidence of discussions and collaboration with the 'end client'

Assessment areas include:

- 1. text and graphics clearly communicate the message of your client
- 2. product will be seen or used by a large number of people
- 3. product design demonstrates clarity and originality
- 4. evidence of collaboration with your client

Examples:

- 1. flyer or pamphlet
- 2. set of forms
- 3. series of handout materials for a teacher and their class

Project Proposal will include

- 1. Preliminary idea
 - done with paper and pencil
- 2. Name of client(s), purpose of materials, intended audience

Possible clients or audiences

- 1. teachers or school staff
- 2. Quincinera
- 3. club or sporting group
- 4. a local business
