

More than one Email address and Inbox

I have had a question re how using Sonic you can set up more than one email address. I will talk about how Sonic does this, but each ISP (Internet Service Provider) will have a different set of rules and/or methods.

You need one paid email address and then with that ISP (Sonic, Comcast, AT&T) you can have several more mail boxes (email addresses) with that ISP, and also in addition to that several free ones such as gmail from google, yahoo.com , outlook.com, zoho, and the list goes on. Start at http://email.about.com/od/freemailreviews/tp/free_email.htm as a possible list of free emails

To use Sonic to create new email addresses and accounts use the following information:

1. For Sonic.net you are able to add up to 15 email addresses with a Fusion account including your main username. You can login to Member Tools as the main username and follow this path: Sonic members Home > Email> Manage mail boxes. Now create a new email address and password.
2. Then after you create a new Sonic.net mailbox (email address) through Member Tools, in order to receive emails to that new address you'll need to log into Webmail or Thunderbird, or whichever mail client you use, using the new email account username and password that you created; you'll need to log into each account you have created separately to receive emails for the individual accounts.

For Thunderbird, if you wish to get all the emails for your separate accounts like gmail, outlook.com, sonic.net, etc. in one location such as Thunderbird then you can setup each account (File>New>Existing Mail Account ...) then click on "continue" and be sure to click on IMap because that will coordinate accounts in Thunderbird.

And remember that if you have something other than Sonic.net and if you use something other than Thunderbird, the above could be quite different.
