On the Way to Running Y

From Portland/Eugene, OR

Head south on I-5 ...

Make **Roseburg** one of your first scenic stops. Located in the **Umpqua Valley**, Roseburg is rich in Oregon history and culture. The **Douglas County Museum** contains artifacts that cover 8,000 years of state history. The **Roseburg Visitors Bureau** offers assistance with three driving tours. There are also six wineries in the area where you can taste some of Oregon's finest wines, and the **Umpqua River** offers spectacular views. The **Rogue River** runs through **Grants Pass**, known as the white-water-rafting capital of Oregon. Be sure to visit the town's many historic homes and fascinating antique shops. A jet boat tour on the Rogue will introduce you to rugged canyons and local wildlife.

Back on I-5, heading south...

Just off I-5 is the town of **Gold Hill** and the **House of Mystery** where gravity has strange effects. **Jacksonville**, farther south, is also a short detour off I-5. This old Gold Rush town features museums. Continuing south you'll come to the city of **Ashland**. From mid-February through October, Ashland hosts the award-winning **Oregon Shakespeare Festival**, presenting afternoon and evening plays on many unique stages. Other attractions in Ashland include art galleries, antique shops, boutiques and Victorian homes.

From Bend, OR

Drive south on US 97...

5 miles south of Bend, visit the High Desert Museum, appropriate for all ages. The museum offers living history exhibits, wildlife, indoor and outdoor exhibits. Open year-round.

From Sacramento, CA

Drive north on I-5 ...

You will come to **Redding** and the **Whiskeytown Shasta-Trinity National Recreation Area** and **Shasta National Forest**. Here you can visit the **Lake Shasta Caverns** and the dam at **Lake Shasta**. Local museums feature exhibits from Gold Rush days and Native American artifacts. **Mt. Shasta**, at 14,162 feet, is the next scenic stop. The **Mt. Shasta Fish Hatchery** produces five to ten million trout annually, and the nearby museum contains interesting geologic and human artifacts. Travel north on US 97 to Klamath Falls, or continue north on I-5 until you reach Ashland.

Driving Directions

From Bend, OR:

- Take US 97 South to Klamath Falls.
- Take San Francisco/Weed exit, continuing on Hwy 97 S.
- Take the Medford Hwy 140 exit toward Ashland/Medford.
- At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn right and drive approximately 100 yards to stoplight and turn right to continue on Hwy 140 West toward Lake of the Woods/Fish Lake/Medford.
- The resort entrance is 7 miles ahead on the right.
- **Proceed through the main entrance and turn left at the four way stop (intersection of Coopers Hawk and Running Y Road).**
- **Take the next right just past the market**
- **Proceed uphill, and the check-in office is in the 3rd building on the right. Parking is on the left.**

From San Francisco, CA:

- Take I-5 North to Weed and exit to US 97 north, continuing to Klamath Falls.
- As you approach Klamath Falls, take the Hwy 140/66 exit toward Ashland/Medford.
- At the stop sign, turn left and cross under the overpass.
- At the traffic light, turn right, following Hwy 140 WEST.
- The resort entrance is 7 miles ahead on the right.
- Follow the **bold** directions from Bend.

From Portland/Eugene, OR:

- Take I-5 South through Eugene and exit onto Hwy 58 East toward Oakridge.
- Drive 90 miles to the junction with Hwy 97 South.
- Continue on Hwy 97 South, and follow the directions from Bend.

From Medford/Grants Pass:

- Exit I-5 onto Hwy 62 to White City.
- At White City, turn right onto Hwy 140 East and continue 61 miles.
- The resort entrance is on the left.
- Follow the **bold** directions from Bend.

Klamath Falls Airport to Resort:

- Head west on Summers Lane toward OR-140 East/Southside expressway.
- Take the 1st left onto OR-140 W/Southside expressway.
- Turn right on OR-140 W/Falls Hwy.
- Turn right on Running Y road.
- Follow the **bold** directions from Bend.

Amtrak Station to Resort: (10 miles from the resort).

- Catch a cab 5 miles to Klamath Falls Airport, where you can rent a car. Follow directions above.
