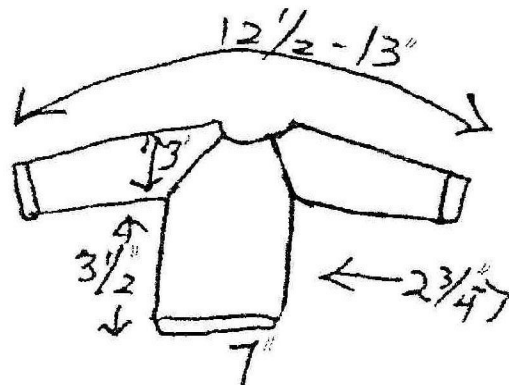


Raglan Sweater for 16" Children's Village Doll

Members of the Sonoma County Knitting Guild knit doll sweaters and accessories for the 16" Waldorf dolls which are then sold to finance the construction and maintenance of Children's Village - and then given to the children in foster care.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Chest 13"; Length 6½"; Wrist to wrist 12½" to 13; Bottom to armhole 3½"; Bottom to shoulder 6" to 7"; Arm length 2¾".



MATERIALS:

- 50gm ball of Paton's Astra or 180 yards of any sport weight yarn that will knit to gauge.
- US 3 & 4 double pointed needles
- US 4 16" circular needle
- Stitch markers

GAUGE: 6 stitches = 1" on size 4 needles

STITCH PATTERNS: 2x2 Rib.

Row 1: k2, p2 repeat to end. Row 2: Knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches, as they face you.

BODY: With size 3 needles, cast on 84 sts and join and do four rows of 2x2 Rib.

Change to size 4 needles and knit in rounds to 3½".

Bind off 4 stitches. K34 sts, bind off 8 sts, K34sts, bind off 4 sts.

Break yarn. Put open (live) sts on a holder or piece of yarn.

SLEEVES: Knitted flat. With size 3 needles, cast on 34 sts. Do four rows of 2x2 Rib. Change to size 4 needles. Knit in stockinette to 2¾", increasing one st on each side three times, to 40 sts. Bind off 4 sts on each side for underarm. Make a second sleeve. Place open sts on a holder.

YOKE: With size 4 needles, and with right sides facing, pick up sts from sleeve (32 sts), place marker, pick up sts from back (34 sts), place marker, pick up sts from sleeve (32 sts), place marker, pick up sts from front (34 sts), place marker (132 sts total). Row 1: knit one round, decreasing one st before and after each marker. Row 2: knit all stitches. Repeat these rows until 60 sts remain.

At front, put center 10 sts on a holder. Work back and forth on size 4 needles continuing to decrease, to 42 sts (once). Change to size 3 needles for 2x2 Rib, 4 sts at front, 10 sts from holder, then balance of sts. Make four rows of the ribbing. Bind off.

The Children's Village 16" Doll Measurements	Knitting Gauges for a 13 Inch Sweater Body
Head: 12½"	4.5 sts/inch = 60 sts
Neck: 8"	5 sts/inch = 65 sts
Shoulder: 6"	5.5 sts/inch = 72 sts
Body: 13" around; 6" long	6 sts/inch = 78 sts
Arm: 7" around; 6½" long	7 sts/inch = 92 sts
Leg: 7" around; 5½" long
