PLUMLINE OUTBACK ROARING SUCCESS

Mike Jordan and Cindy Whitehead - 7500
Joe Sloup and Jan Daley - Ultimate Kamikaze

With twice the turn out of last year's Plumline event, the Outback went off nearly perfectly on the longest day of the year.

Hank Barlow, Editor of *Mountain Bike Magazine*, called the Ultimate Kamikaze an awesome event in a truly classic setting.

Don Douglass, Outback Director, said he was particularly proud of the Safety Committee's work and the careful riding shown by the racers. There were no serious injuries and no one was hospitalized in the 15 miles, 7000 ft. descent.

On Sunday, June 22, the Sierra 7500 was held under clear skies and unlimited visibility. The snow patches at the 11,000 ft. level of Lookout Mountain didn't bother racers as much as the 3 miles of sand at the outlet of Coyote Canyon, caused by the extraordinarily heavy runoff this year.

During the video interviews at both Laws Railroad Museum and Mill Pond Rec Area, happy but exhausted participants indicated that this was their biggest mountain bike challenge ever. Video tapes will be available for August 15 delivery, and race results can be found below.

1987 Outback Schedule

A canvas of the many land management officials involved with the Outback route indicated that participant's conduct was good, and that there were no negative problems. A green light has been given for the Third Annual Plumline Outback and is scheduled for June 20-21, 1987. The community of Bishop has indicated it will increase its support for next year, and a number of sponsors are being lined up to provide major prize money.

Don Douglass announced that beginning next year a King of the Mountain Award of \$100 will be paid to the first male cyclist to beat Joe Murrav's 1985 time of 3 hours 2 minutes to Check Point 5 on Lookout Mountain and a Queen of the Mountain Award of \$100 to the first female to beat Cindy Whitehead's 1986 time of 4 hours 13 minutes, to the same point.

Mike Jordan of Ross wrote that he thought the race was one of the hardest races he'd ever done, with the most challenging terrain, but at the same time it was fun.

Features of the Plumline Outback the riders like will be retained, such as the complementary dinnere at the finish of the Ultimate Kamikaze, and at the Sierra 7500, the 6 Aid Stations with full water bottle replacements, oranges, bananas and cookies, complementary drinks for finishers, as well as snacks at the finish line.

Larger route signs at two or three points of confusion will be posted, and better race timing and faster results will be prepared for.

The Bishop Chamber of Commerce will again go out of its way to make every Outback participant feel welcome and comfortable. Plan to the join the top in mountain bike action in Bishop, June 20-21, 1987!

Dunes by Moonlight, October 11-12

Plumline will sponsor the Third Dunes by Moonlight Mountain Bike Ride, October 11-12, 1986. The ride to California's tallest sand dune starts in Big Pine, crosses the Inyo Mountains and drops down into remote Eureka Valley, a starkly beautiful area north of Death Valley. This bike ride is suitable for cyclists 18-80 who are in good physical condition and able to cycle a moderately strenuous 50 miles each way. (Truck rides available on the return climb.) Because there are no services of any kind available in this area, all supplies, food and water must be carried by 4-Wheel Drive. USFS Naturalist Joan Benner will join us again to interpret the unique environment of Eureka Valley and lead the campfire program. Cost for the two day ride which includes a gourmet supper, breakfast and sag support is \$60. For information and application write to Plumline, 3891 N. Ventura Ave., Ventura, CA 93001. Group size is limited to 25.
