Poster Requirements Continued:

- You might have problems with some of the accent marks in the text files. Look at the samples to make the correct marks.
- You must use at least one eps graphic. You can use some from the graphics folder in the Lab 4Provence folder or you can find some on your own.
- You must use text wrap on at least one eps graphic.
- If desired, include some simple background shape or shapes.
- When finished, save your document. To print out your document and tile it, you'll need to choose the **File...Print** menu twice (once for each tile). The first time you print, you'll probably output the top or left tile. Then, use the Page tool to set the tile properly to the bottom or right portion and print again. With a little trimming and tape, you've got yourself a tabloid poster!

You must include at least one text wrap in your document. The text formatting should be consistent, readable and serve the purpose of advertising the trip in an appealing manner. Creative use of text is a plus!

You'll visit the French Riviera, Cannes, Avignon, the Luberon Forests, Roussillon, Aix-en-Provence, the Gorges du Verdon and other interesting villages and sites of Provence.

Tour Director - Led Walks

Day 3: Ste. Baume Walk
 This morning's walk (2 hours) was once a pilgrimage for medieval travelers who came to Mount Ste. Baume to pray at the shrine of Mary Magdalene. Later that afternoon, visit Avignon, in the heart of the Provence region.

Day 5: Luberon Forest Walk
 Drive through the countryside to the Luberon region, setting for Peter Mayle's acclaimed book, *A Year in Provence*. Your walk in the Luberon Forest (1.5 hours) takes you through groves of oak and cedar. Overlooks provide spectacular views of the surrounding mountain villages. After the walk, pass through some of the area's most scenic towns, such as Bonnieux, Lacoste or Menerbes, before reaching Fontaine de Vaucluse, a river source that emanates from deep inside a rocky hillside.

Day 6: Gordes & Roussillon
 Visit the Abbey of Sénanque and the perfectly preserved hilltop town of Gordes. Reach Roussillon, considered by many to be one of France's most picturesque villages. Today's walk (45 min.) takes you through the open-air ochre mines of Roussillon. After your walk, transfer to the Vignos sur Verdon area. Later, participate in our optional "Pétanque & Paris" event, at which a local will teach you the beloved Provençal game of pétanque, followed by a glass of the aperitif pastis.

Day 7: Lake d'Esparron Walk
 Begin the day with an exhilarating 1.5 hour walk along the shores of Lake d'Esparron. That afternoon, enjoy free time to spend at your leisure in the Vignos sur Verdon region, or join our optional "Footsteps of Cézanne" excursion, introducing you to Cézanne's hometown of Aix and the sun-dappled Provençal landscapes he painted.

Day 8: Gorges du Verdon & Moustiers Ste. Marie
 Continue through scenic countryside to the Gorges du Verdon area. Known as the Grand Canyon of France, the Gorges du Verdon are among the most impressive natural attractions in Europe. Visit the village of Moustiers Ste. Marie, known throughout Europe for its fine blue and white ceramics. From there, travel along the Routes des Crêtes as you make your way back to the French Riviera.

Day 9: Cap Ferrat Walk
 Start the day with a walk on the Cap Ferrat, the peninsula separating Nice from the principality of Monaco. Your walk along a dramatic cliffside path takes you around the edge of the peninsula, with memorable views of the Mediterranean and the Côte d'Azur (1.5 hours). In the afternoon, opt for an excursion to the artists' enclave of St. Paul de Vence.
