

Lab 7: Styles, Effects, and the Appearance Palette Create Flowers

Part 1: Hour Exercises

Complete Hour 11 (complete the exercises) and Hour 18 for live effects.

Part 2: Create a bouquet of flowers


- 1. On a letter size document create flower shapes and apply styles to them. Combine shapes, brushes, any other tools you desire. You may want to use layers to organize shapes. Add other shapes-maybe a vase and background.
- 2. You must include (minimum 2 of each): shapes with a "premade" style applied from any of the Style libraries other than the default palette; shapes made using new styles that you have altered in the appearance palette; new styles made entirely by you from scratch (and saved in the styles palette). One of your original styles must include multiple strokes and/or fills.
- 3. Include at least one Effect and tell me which one(s) you used. _

4. For *** put your name in an auto-resizable shape. To do this start by typing your first name. Select name (with selection tool), open the Appearance palette and Add New Fill from palette options. The Fill will be placed above Characters so move it below. With this fill selected

in Appearance palette, choose Effect..Convert to Shape; select one of the shape choices and add desired width. Apply color to the Live Shape. Type your last name and the "Live" shape should adjust to accommodate the new text.

Try adding a second Fill below the first and add width/height. You can even add effects to the fills. Be sure you position the Characters above the fills.

5. So that I can identify the styles: Label your styles (default, modified, new) OR create labeled samples on a second sheet.
