Labs are based on a 4-star grading system:

- ★★★★ Reflects highest level of performance. Exceeds lab objectives for Illustrator skills/features used or presentation of Illustrator objects. (A)
- ★★★ Reflects mastery of performance. All lab objectives are complete. (B)
- ★★ Reflects movement towards mastery. Most lab objectives are complete but minor details need attention. (C)
- ★ Reflects a beginning level of performance. More work needed. Major elements are missing. (D)

Labs will be returned to you in class or in the lab. NEVER put an uncorrected lab in the cubby for grading. No work is accepted after our last class meeting.
