New Adobe Programs: Adobe has announced that they will be releasing CS4 on September 23. There are some major changes in CS4 as compared to CS3 and CS2. With the CS4 release, the Flash program is completely different. With the new release Flash is easier to learn and use. There is little change in Photoshop. It is a slightly more user friendly. Photoshop has been the standard of the industry for some time and it is hard to conceive of any major changes to improve the product. CS4 is a more massive program than its predecessor, CS3. It is not for you if you do not have a modern high-speed computer with a lot of RAM and gigabytes of storage. With a price of about \$1000 for the program it is not for most computer users. If you want the latest and best, Adobe continues to lead the industry with its CS4 release.
