Rabbi Franzel

Our retreat facilitator, Rabbi Ethan Franzel, serves Main Line Reform Temple Beth Elohim in Wynnewood, PA. He received rabbinic ordination at Hebrew Union College, New York in 2001, where he studied Hasidism and Kabbalah with Rabbi Lawrence Kushner.

Rabbi Franzel has created a variety of alternative worship experiences, utilizing meditative and contemplative techniques. A long time practitioner of meditation and chant, he teaches courses on Kabbalah, Hasidism, Jewish spirituality, and meditation. An avid musician, many of the musical settings he uses for his meditation workshops are his own compositions. His melody for Psalms 27:4 was published in R'fuah Sh'leimah: Songs of Jewish Healing. In 2005, Ethan's Niggun, was published in Nigun Anthology Volume I by Transcontinental Music.

Bittul haYesh: Uncovering the Authentic Self

Authenticity in Jewish spirituality can be aptly described not as adding God into our lives, but rather as the process of peeling away the layers of ego and falsehood – those parts of ourselves that keep us from the Truth. This process reveals to us that God has always been an integral part of ourselves.

With the dynamic Rabbi Ethan Franzel of Wynnewood, PA, our wonderful, local Rabbi Lavey Derby of Kol Shofar, teachers, musicians, and each other, we will use meditation, sacred chant, and especially the practice of contemplation and self-inquiry in order to reach the divine truth of our authentic selves, remembering who we really are. Practicing hitbodedut/contemplation of spiritual wisdom, sacred text becomes our mirror, revealing to us the true aspects of ourselves. The Retreat Band will provide amazing live music as we practice meditative chanting. The weekend also includes yoga, drumming and art workshops, and prayerful movement.
